Investment Case Prepared for Kochi's *Pokkali* Fields, Mangroves

An investment case on nature-based solutions, focusing on mangroves and *pokkali* in Kochi, has been developed under the INTERACT-Bio project, supported by Germany's Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Nuclear Safety and Consumer Protection (BMU). *Pokkali* is an ancient organic farming practice, where one season of paddy cultivation using a unique saline tolerant rice variety is alternated with another season of prawn culture in the water-logged coastal regions of Kerala.

Air Quality Project to Help Delhi-NCR Breathe Easier

Four municipal corporations in the Delhi-National Capital Region will receive technical assistance in developing generic actions to improve air quality. Under ICLEI South Asia's new project on 'Building City Leadership on Clean Air Action in Delhi-NCR', supported by Clean Air Fund, the East Delhi Municipal Corporation, Municipal Corporation of Gurugram, Meerut Municipal Corporation and South Delhi Municipal Corporation will also be supported in exploring potential partnerships to design and implement pilot projects.

Illustrated Maps to Detail Abundant Natural Capital of Jammu, Srinagar

Illustrated Natural Assets Maps are being developed for the cities of Jammu and Srinagar, as part of the BMU supported INTERACT-Bio project. The map will help to communicate the significance of urban biodiversity to citizens and tourists. Field visits have been completed, and the natural assets of the cities have been mapped on the Geographic Information System (GIS) platform.

Goa's Urban *Khazans*: Initiative to Focus on Conservation Strategies

ICLEI South Asia, with support from Azim Premji University, Bengaluru, has initiated a project on conserving the centuries-old *khazans* of Goa, which not only protect their surrounding areas from the influence of the sea, but also provide the people of Goa their staple 'fish curry and rice'. In this regard, experts and practitioners brainstormed on *khazans* and the

ecosystem services they provide at a workshop in Panaji, ahead of preparing a strategy and action plan.


Andhra Pradesh: Project to Improve Mainstreaming of Climate Action in 3 Cities

Three cities in Andhra Pradesh - Vijayawada, Kakinada and Tirupati – will receive assistance in mainstreaming climate considerations into the planning, financing and delivery of their urban services, under a new project launched by ICLEI South Asia, with support from the Children's Investment Fund Foundation. The cities will also be supported in improving their Climate-Smart Cities Assessment Framework rankings over the next two reporting cycles, and in developing bankable projects on low-carbon and climate-resilient development in priority sectors.
