Hope you all had a pleasant start to the New Year. We kick-started 2022 with a bunch of new developments, both in terms of ongoing activities and venturing into new areas with exciting initiatives. We are also happy to announce that ICLEI South Asia is growing, with over 70 staff supporting South Asian cities, as well as national and subnational governments.

January started with the inauguration of groundwater recharge systems involving rainwater harvesting at two public schools in Nagpur, Maharashtra, with support from Nagpur Municipal Corporation and Nagpur Smart and Sustainable City Development Corporation Limited. The initiative was implemented under the European Commissionfunded Urban-LEDS II project.

Our team also conducted a plastic waste survey in Surat, Gujarat, under the Alliance + ICLEI Developing Plastic Waste-Free Cities project, funded by the Alliance to End Plastic Waste. The data and information gathered from the survey will help Surat Municipal Corporation to develop a plastic waste management action plan. More details can be found in an article in this edition. We have also come out with insightful knowledge products, such as training manuals on climate resilience for local governments in Nepal and Bangladesh. Three policy briefs on building climate resilience and reducing heat impacts are also being prepared under the Climate Development and Knowledge Network programme.

We have had a series of webinars on improving climate transparency

and reducing finance gaps under the Asia LEDS Partnership programme. In addition, to mark the completion of the Urban-LEDS II project, a closure webinar highlighted the project achievements, including capacity building and mainstreaming of climate actions in city planning. 
Latest developments

तोड़-तोड़ के बन्धनों को, देखो बहनें आती हैं ...

सुदूर आदिवासी अंचल से उदयपुर आकर आशा सहयोगिनी बनी गीता गरासिया की कहानी



"मेरा नाम गीता गरासिया है। मैं कोटड़ा तहसील (जिला- उदयपुर) की बेड़ाधर पंचायत के खोलिया फला गाँव की रहने वाली हूँ। मेरा घर उदयपुर शहर से लगभग १०० किलोमीटर दूर है। मेरे पूरे गाँव में मैं पहली लड़की हूँ, जिसने दसवीं और फिर बारहवीं पास की। सात भाई बहिनों में मेरा नंबर चौथा है। मुझसे बड़ी तीन बहनें हैं। हमारे पास एक छोटी सी खेती की ज़मीन है, जिस पर हम मक्का, उड़द और गेंहू उगाते हैं।

बचपन से मेरी एक जैसी दिनचर्या रही।मैं सुबह बकरियां चराती, छोटे भाई बहनों को संभालती और जंगल से लकड़ियाँ भी लाती। मेरा घर एक पहाड़ी पर है। घर से आधा किलोमीटर नीचे उतरकर नदी और हैंडपंप से पानी भरना भी मेरा और मेरी बहन का काम था।मेरे गाँव में पिछले साल ही सोलर बिजली पहुंची है। जंगल की ज़मीन होने के कारण हमारे यहाँ बिजली के खम्भे नहीं लग सकते।गाँव तक जाने के लिए मुख्य सड़क से ३ किलोमीटर कच्ची पगडण्डी पर पैदल चलना पड़ता है।पांचवीं तक का स्कूल तो गाँव में ही था, उसके बाद ३ किलोमीटर दूर पंचायत तक आकर आठवीं तक पढ़ाई की। जब घर वालों ने घरेलू काम और बकरियां चराने के लिए दबाव डाला तो आगे नियमित छात्रा के तौर पर कभी स्कूल नहीं गयी। मेरे घर वाले मुझे मज़दुरी के लिए मेरी बहनों के साथ गुजरात भेजना चाहते थे। मैंने मना कर दिया। मेरी ज़िद रंग लाई। पर मैं अपनी बहनों को गुजरात जाने से नहीं रोक पाई। मैंने घर के काम करते- करते पहले दसवीं और फिर बारहवीं प्राइवेट (पत्राचार) पास की। मैं आगे पढ़ाई करके नौकरी करना चाहती थी,पर घर वाले तैयार नहीं थे।दिन ऐसे ही गुज़र रहे थे।
