Dear readers,

We have just returned from the World Urban Forum that was held in Katowice, Poland and are happy to report significant developments from the event. Apart from presenting our impactful work at various sessions, we also launched ICLEI South Asia's annual report. A detailed article with all the highlights from the Forum is included in this edition.

Among the key developments in our projects, we recently inaugurated a nature interpretation zone in Kochi to raise awareness about the various ecosystems in the city and the biodiversity they have. The zone, developed under the INTERACT-Bio project, which is funded by the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety through the International Climate Initiative, was inaugurated by Honourable Mayor of Kochi, Adv. M. Anil Kumar. As part of the same project, Illustrated Natural Asset Maps of Jammu and Srinagar were released by Honourable Lt. Governor of Jammu and Kashmir Mr. Manoj Sinha on the occasion of World Environment Day. The maps aim to communicate the significance and need to conserve urban biodiversity.

Mr. Sinha, along with state Chief Secretary Mr. A.K. Mehta, also released the Urban Systems Gap Analysis reports prepared for the cities of Srinagar and Jammu. These reports are the first steps towards the preparation of Climate Resilient City Action Plans for Srinagar and Jammu, which will help the two cities as well as the state of Jammu and Kashmir to stride towards low-carbon, climate resilient development and attain carbon neutrality.

We also organised workshops for the Municipal Corporations of Delhi and Meerut, under the Building City Leadership on Clean Air Action project, on enhancing green cover to reduce air pollution. The project

is being supported by the Clean Air Fund. Under the Climate Development and Knowledge Network programme, we released a policy brief on climate resilience planning in Nepal and also launched the Voluntary Local Review report prepared for Singra, Bangladesh.

Building on the success of our Building Energy Accelerator project, we have launched a new project in Nagpur to advance decarbonisation of buildings. All these developments are featured in this edition.
