Dear Friends,

It's 2023, and the world has only seven years left to fulfil the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Today, it seems to be a gargantuan task because the future has already arrived; the projections of climate change impact made just a few years ago are now a reality. However, I believe that it's still not too late, that we can still mitigate the impacts, despite the stunning reality of melting glaciers, extensive heat waves and deadly floods.

In a significant development that could help spur positive action, India took over the G20 presidency last month. We are now in a unique position to help shape the climate narrative over the next one year. Accelerating the SDGs is one of seven selected task forces during India's presidency; it is hoped India emerges as the voice that upholds the concerns of the Global South, such as ensuring access to climate finance. I hope that there is also greater cooperation on shared goals to drive climate-smart and sustainable actions.

We are proud to be associated with Urban 20 (U20), an engagement group under G20, which strives to establish engagement among participating cities from G20 countries, as well as other observer cities, to develop a collective message that emphasises the role of cities in taking forward the sustainable development agenda. As technical and knowledge partner to U20, we are providing local support to Ahmedabad city for the upcoming U20 Inception Event (Sherpa Meeting) to be held on 9th and 10th of February 2023 and U20 Mayoral Summit to be held in July 2023.

At ICLEI South Asia, we ended the year 2022 on a high note, with an array of activities that advanced complex themes such as managing emission risks and air pollution, energy efficiency, integrated urban

planning and green economy. The synergy we continue to have with our members, donors, partners and people across countries gives me hope that the tide will turn and that this year, there will be greater progress across the world on limiting global warming.




