ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability, South Asia, is seeking a dynamic and creative individual to join our Communications team as a **Communications Associate**. This is a **full-time**, **onsite** position located in our New Delhi office, offering an exciting opportunity to grow and excel in the field of communications. In this role, you will assist in managing and implementing external and internal communication plans and activities for the South Asia Secretariat. You will collaborate closely with the ICLEI South Asia Communications Team to develop and execute communication strategies aimed at enhancing the visibility and recognition of ICLEI South Asia's initiatives among diverse stakeholders, including government officials, private sector entities, non-governmental organizations, media outlets, donors, and civil society organizations. Reporting to the Communications Manager, you will work in close coordination with various project teams to ensure the effective dissemination of our mission and achievements.

Key Responsibilities:

The following is the list of typical tasks and responsibilities expected to be executed by the Communications Associate at ICLEI South Asia:

- Monthly Newsletter: Collaborate with project teams to create monthly e-newsletters, incorporating project updates, publication launches, blogs, and upcoming events. Write, rewrite, and edit articles while ensuring the quality of work and adherence to ICLEI's communication standards and guidelines for all communication materials. Provide support to the designer in the newsletter production.
- Content Creation: Generate compelling and engaging content (written and visual), including
 press releases, blog posts, articles, and multimedia materials, to support communication
 initiatives.
- **Social Media Management:** Plan and execute social media campaigns and strategies for various projects as well as regular updates.
- Website Management: Contribute to the upkeep and enhancement of the organization's website
 by regularly updating content and ensuring its alignment with communication goals. Coordinating
 with project teams and website agency teams for the upkeep of project websites.



- **Documentation Support:** Assist in note-taking, summarizing events, and crafting articles, contributing to the overall documentation of events and webinars.
- **Brand Management:** Ensure consistency in branding across all communication materials and channels, adhering to established ICLEI South Asia guidelines.
- **Media Relations:** Foster and maintain relationships with media contacts, journalists, and influencers to enhance the organization's media coverage and visibility.
- **Collaboration:** Work closely with cross-functional teams, including designers and project teams to align communication efforts with project goals.
- **Photography and Videography**: If relevant, capture high-quality photos and videos for use in communication materials, ensuring proper archiving and organisation of multimedia assets.

Required/Desired Skills:

- Outstanding spoken and written English skills
- Master's degree in communications, journalism, digital marketing, or related fields
- 2-5 years' experience in communications, journalism, digital marketing, or a similar role
- Experience or a good understanding of the development sector, climate change and environmental issues will be an asset
- Previous experience in a development sector organisation in a similar capacity is desirable
- Knowledge of MS Office, social media, Canva and CMS software is a requirement
- Knowledge of design software such as Photoshop and InDesign, as well as HTML language is desirable
- Excellent writing and editing skills, and attention to detail
- Ability to write at different levels (subject-based writing, reports, journalistic writing, and webbased snippets) keeping in mind the target audience and the medium
- Ability to work independently and proactively
- Enthusiastic attitude and willingness to learn, adapt and take on a wide range of tasks
- Ability to multitask and work under tight deadlines
- A good understanding of Hindi and other Indian languages will be an asset
