Dear readers,

A warm welcome to this October edition! A lot has been happening this past month, and we have got it summed up nicely. We organised several activities to mark the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies, as part of our initiatives to spread awareness about the challenge posed by air pollution, and the measures that are needed to reduce it. In Delhi and Meerut, there were events to sensitise sanitation inspectors and children about the issue, in addition to a meeting with senior government officials in Delhi on capacity building and public outreach.

In a related project activity, we organised a training for horticulture officials of Municipal Corporation of Delhi on addressing air pollution through reforestation and low-cost interventions for ecological restoration.

Our commitment to promote electric mobility received new boost with the handing over of 18 electric cargo three-wheelers to Kochi city, with Hon'ble Justice of Kerala High Court, Shri Devan Ramachandran and Hon'ble Mayor, Adv. M. Anil Kumar doing the honours. We also supported a cycling event organised by Decathlon Goa in North Goa, to promote sustainable mobility, fitness and healthy living.

As GHG Platform India Initiative's (GHGPI) technical lead for the waste sector, we contributed to the development of the greenhouse gas emission estimates from the sector. GHGPI held a workshop last month to release these estimates, as well as those from the sectors of energy, industry, agriculture, forest and other land use.

We also have, in this edition, a report on the second roundtable dialogue of the Asia Clean Mobility High Ambition Leadership Group,

and our Hindi blog, which looks at the opening of India's first Child Priority Zone in Udaipur as part of the Urban95 initiative.

### Clean Air for Blue Skies: Activities Put Focus on Air Pollution in National Capital Region

Several awareness activities were conducted in Delhi and Meerut to mark the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies.
